4.2 It will further be blissful to take note that letters serial no. $13,40,61,67,70,98,152$ and 198, at eight placement letter Raif (रेफ्) has been associated values ( $2,1,1,1,1,1$, 1,2 ) that is total values 10 while letter Raif (र्रेफ) with its value 3 makes value 24 for its placement eight times, makes value $3 \times 8=24$, and the reduced value $24-10=14$, deserves to be glimpsed and imbibed as virtue of organization.
4.3 One may have a pause here and take note that value 14 with its organization as $14=2+3+4+5$, is parallel to four folds manifestation layers $(2,3,4,5)$ of hyper cube 4 , the representative regular body of 4 -space manifesting along the format of idol of Lord Brahma.
4.4 Further, TCV (व्यास) $=14$.
4.5 One may further have a pause here and take note that with addition of value 14 to value 704 of total TCV value of entire range of 214 letters will bring the TCV value as $704+14=718$.
4.6 One may further a pause here and take note that 718 with its organization $718=100+18$ brings us face to face with value $700=70 \times 10$ and $18=3+4+5+6$.
4.7 The organization $700=70 \times 10$ bring us face to face with the split of domain at its fifth split phase as of value 70 and such split within ten creative boundary Components of transcendental domain will make the value $70 \times 10=$ 700.
4.8 Further value $18=3+4+5+6$ is parallel to four folds manifestation layer ( $3,4,5,6$ ) of hyper cube 5 , the representative regular body of 5 -space manifesting within 4-space.
4.9 One may further have a pause here and to permit the transcending mind to glimpse and imbibe these values and features.
4.10 It will be further be blissful to take note that, 214 letters with TCV value 718 brings us face to face with the organization $718=214+504$.
4.11 Further, $504=496+8$.
4.12 Further, 496 is a perfect number accepting 9 proper divisors (1, 2, 4, 8, 16, 31, 62, 124, 248).
4.13 And further, 9 points range has eight gaps.
4.14 Further, TCV (Akash) $=8$.
4.15 One may have a pause here and to permit the transcending mind to continuously remain in prolonged sitting of trans and to glimpse and imbibe these values and features.

## 5. TRANSCEND TO ENRICH FURTHER INSIGHT

5.1 Sadhakas fulfilled with intensity of urge further enrich insight about the values and virtues of 28 transcendental designations of वेद व्यास (Ved Vyas) shall revisit formulation वेद व्यास (Ved Vyas) accepting transcendental code value 34 .
5.2 One may have a pause here and take note that value 34 accepts organization as $34=7+8+9+10$, which is parallel
to four folds manifestation layers ( $7,8,9,10$ ) of hyper cube 9 , the representative regular body of 9 -space within 4 -space.
5.3 One shall permit the transcending mind to glimpse and imbibe these values and virtues.
5.4 One shall transcends further to sequentially glimpse 28 transcendental designation of वेद व्यास (Ved Vyas) in terms of the transcendental values range of these designation:
(1) श्वेत Letters $5 \mathrm{TCV}=20$
