

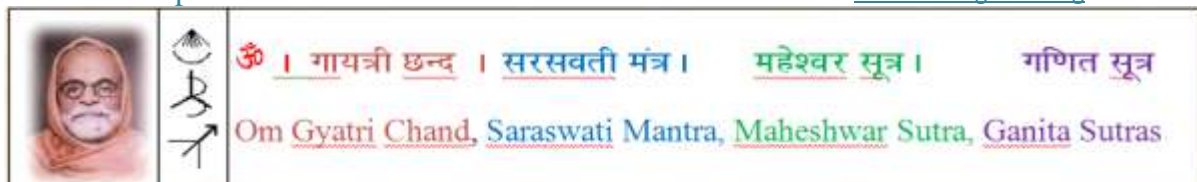

Dictionary and Referencer

1. One of the basic assignment would be to compile referencer and dictionaries of Vedic mathematics, Science & Technology.
2. Here below are being pointed about the nature of this assignment and the need for VMS & T referencer and VMS & T dictionaries, which may unfold on the following lines.
2. VMS & T
VMS & T is abbreviation / nomenclature in short form of 'Vedic mathematics, Science & Technology'.
3. Vedic mathematics, Science and Technology
Vedic mathematics, Science & Technology is a complete Discipline in itself. It is an ancient Discipline of Vedic Systems. It is distinct than the Disciplines of Vedic Mathematics, Vedic Sciences as well as Vedic technologies. In simple terms it may be said that the Discipline of Vedic mathematics, Science & Technology (VMS & T) is Values Essence of the values of whole range of Vedic knowledge including Vedic Mathematics, Vedic Sciences, as well as Vedic technologies.

VMS & T CONCEPTS REFERENCER

1. VMS & T Concepts Referencer
The compilation being made here is being designated as 'VMS & T Concepts Referencer'
Here the aim is to give lead for and as introductory definition features of the technical terms / concepts / formulations, working rules, symbols, nomenclature in short forms / abbreviations etc. of the Discipline of Vedic mathematics, Science & Technology.

5. Numbers values formats

6. श्री: (Sri)

‘श्री: Sri’ is the transcendental reservoir of values essence of the order of Vedas. The transcendental (5-space) code value (TCV) of the formulation (श्री:) is ‘20’ which is parallel to TCV (वेद) = 20. The TCV (श्री:) = 2 + 1 + 4 + 13 = 20.

TCV (श्री) = 2 + 1 + 4 = 7.

The organization $20 = 7 + 13$ and the organization $7 = 2 + 1 + 4 = 2^1 + 2^0 + 2^2$, as such leads us to any internal format features of this formulation. The reach from formulation ‘श्री:’ to formulation (वेद) and the other way round from formulation (वेद:) to formulation (श्री:) deserve to be chased for complete coverage of the values essence range of the Discipline of VMS & T.

7. ॐ (Om)

ॐ (Om) is the self referral (6-space) transcendental (5-space) reservoir of whole range of values of Existence Phenomenon covered by values essence range of Ved, including the transcendental (5-space) base of manifestation format of Vedas.

TCV (ॐ) = 16 and TCV (वेद) = 20 as a values pair (16, 20) in terms of its organization (4 x 4, 4 x 5) brings to focus the transcendental (5-space) inter relationship of four fold manifestation format and five fold transcendental base of manifestation within creator’s space (4-space), which deserve to be chased.

Scripture preserves self referral - transcendental features of (ॐ) as sole syllable Braham.

TCV (श्रीः ॐ) = 36 = TCV (प्रणवः) deserve to be chased.

8. वेद Ved

वेद Ved takes to the root to (विद्) which means knowledge as well as 'to know knowledge'. TCV (विद्) = 15 = TCV (कारण) = TCV (र).

9. Vedic knowledge and for reaching Vedic knowledge sadkhas / students of VMS & T have to visit transcendental (5-space) domain within the solid order dimensional frame of five dimensions synthesizing dimensional frame of linear equivalence value (1 x 3 x 5) = 15.

With it, by visit of the transcendental (5-space) domains the transcending mind of sadkhas shall be going parallel to the transcendental (5-space) carriers of Sunlight where are the transcendental (5-space) printouts of Vedas.

10. वेदःVedas

Braham Rishi Ved Vyas during each Dwapar Yuga re-organizes values essence of Ved as four Vedas namely (Rigved, Yajurved, Samved and Atharavved) by classifying transcendental (5-space) values as Rik, Yajur, Sama and Atharav.

TCV (ऋक) = 5, TCV (यजु) = 11, TCV (साम्) = 15, and TCV (अथर्व) = 17 deserve to be chased to glimpse the features of (ज्योत्ति) with TCV (ज्योत्ति) = 18 manifesting as Rik, Yajur, Sam and Atharav.
